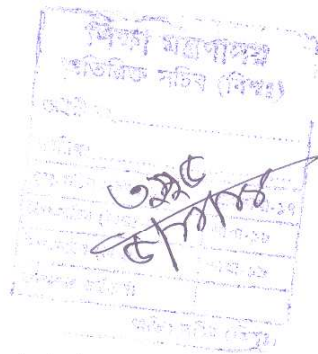

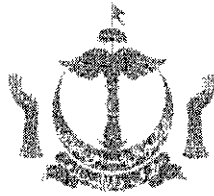

**BRUNEI DARUSSALAM GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP**  
**TO FOREIGN STUDENTS TENABLE IN BRUNEI DARUSSALAM**  
**FOR THE 2015/2016 ACADEMIC SESSION**

With the consent of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam, the Government of Brunei Darussalam is offering annual scholarships under a special scholarship award scheme, for the 2015/2016 academic session.

Tenable in Brunei Darussalam, the aim of the scholarship awards is to provide applicants, with the opportunity to study at Universiti Brunei Darussalam [UBD], Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali [UNISSA] and Institut Teknologi Brunei [ITB].

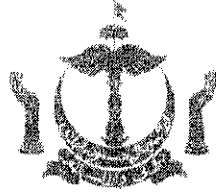
The academic year for UBD, UNISSA and ITB commences in July / August 2015.

**1. ELIGIBILITY**

- 1.1 Citizens of ASEAN, OIC, Commonwealth and ADC member countries and others (including bilateral reciprocal cooperation) are eligible to apply.
- 1.2 Applicants must be between the ages of 18 - 25 for undergraduate programmes and not exceeding the age of 35 for postgraduate programmes on the 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2015.
- 1.3 The award is NOT eligible to Brunei Permanent Residents and foreigners residing in Brunei Darussalam.

**2. TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIP**

- 2.1 The Scholarship award is normally tenable for the minimum period required to obtain the specific degree which is four (4) years for a First Degree with Honours, one (1) to two (2) years for a Master's Degree, three (3) years for a Doctoral Degree at UBD, UNISSA and ITB, three (3) years for Diploma of Health Sciences at UBD, all on a full-time basis.



2.2 The Scholarship award is subject to the scholar maintaining satisfactory conduct and progress in his/her studies. This requires the scholar to maintain an active registration and academic status by passing the prescribed semester examinations and attaining the minimum course credit units. The scholarship will be reviewed at the end of each semester. Should the scholar fail to obtain the minimum course credit units or is placed on probation status, the scholarship award will be terminated and revoked.

2.3 The duration of the scholarship granted will **NOT** be extended in any case, and changes of institution or programme is not permitted.

### **3. THE BENEFITS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

3.1 The Scholarships cover tuition fees and other appropriate compulsory fees as determined by the institutions for the duration of the programme.

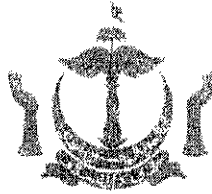
3.2 One return economy class air ticket for the most economically viable route to Brunei Darussalam will be determined by the Government of Brunei Darussalam. No additional assistance will be provided towards other travel expenses.

3.3 Allowances payable will include:

- i) Monthly personal allowance of BND500.00;
- ii) Annual book allowance of BND600.00;
- iii) Monthly food allowance of BND150.00;
- iv) Upon completion of the programme, baggage allowance to a maximum of BND250.00 to a country in the ASEAN region or BND500.00 to countries outside the ASEAN region.

3.4 An accommodation at respective institution's residential college is provided. If the scholar opts not to live in the provided accommodation, no additional allowance will be given in lieu of board and transport.

3.5 Outpatient medical and/or dental treatment is complimentary at any Brunei Government hospitals. However, an administrative charge is payable for each consultation with the government general practitioner or specialist.



3.6 Should the scholar opts to seek medical and/or dental treatment at a private hospital or clinic, all expenses are to be borne by the scholar himself/herself.

3.7 The scholar is **NOT** eligible to claim any other facilities apart from those aforementioned under item 3.

#### **5. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

5.1 Scholars are not encouraged to bring their family members for the duration of the scholarship.

5.2 Spouse and/or child allowance is not payable to the scholar. Accommodation is not provided to an accompanying family member or any other person.

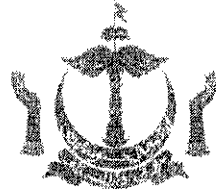
5.3 This scholarship may not be held concurrently with any other scholarship, fellowship, grant or loan without the prior approval of the Government of Brunei Darussalam. This scholarship will be terminated immediately should the scholar be found to concurrently hold another scholarship.

5.4 Under no circumstances are the scholars allowed to leave the country for more than 30 days per academic year without prior permission from the Ministry of Education of Brunei Darussalam. Failure to comply with this condition may lead to the forfeiture of payments of the scholar's monthly allowance.

5.5 The scholar may not undertake paid employment or serve on the staff of their country's representative in Brunei Darussalam during the award.

5.6 The Government of Brunei Darussalam will not be responsible for securing employment for the scholar after graduation.

5.7 An applicant may be required to appear for an interview at such place(s) as may be determined by the institutions offering the

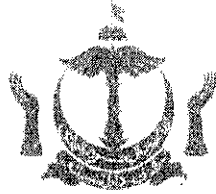


programmes, and to sit a written examination to assess the scholar's proficiency in the English Language / Malay Language / Arabic Language (where applicable).

- 5.8 The scholar must abide by the rules and regulations of the institution of study and the laws of Brunei Darussalam.
- 5.9 The scholarship is granted for studies in Brunei Darussalam only and therefore do not include participation in any form of activities under the Study Abroad Programmes nor the Discovery Year Programmes. The scholar may however choose to participate in such programmes at his/her own expense.
- 5.10 The Government of Brunei Darussalam reserves the right to terminate the scholarship awarded to the scholar as recommended by their respective institution or if deemed to be justifiable.
- 5.11 Upon completion of the programme, the scholar is required to return to their country of origin with immediate effect.
- 5.12 If a scholar wishes to withdraw from the Brunei Darussalam Scholarship during the course of study, the scholar has to give one month advance notice and repay the full costs received by the scholar to the Ministry of Education of Brunei Darussalam. The scholar's return home airfare will be on their own expense.
- 5.13 It is a prerequisite for the scholar to insure themselves with 24 hours traveling and health insurance for the whole duration of their stay in Brunei Darussalam at their own expense.
- 5.14 Application forms must be duly completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the National Focal Point for scholarships in the scholar's country.
- 5.15 Applicants are required to get a security clearance statement from their National Security Agency / Police Station (i.e. clear from any civil and criminal records).

## **6. HEALTH**

- 6.1 The offer is subject to the attainment of a certificate stating that scholars are medically fit to undertake the scholarship to study in Brunei Darussalam, to be issued by a qualified medical practitioner which is registered with the local Government. All charges for the medical expenses are to be borne by the scholar.



- 6.2 Successful applicants need to undergo health screening in Brunei Darussalam if deemed necessary by the Government of Brunei Darussalam. In cases where the applicant does not pass the health screening, they are to return to their home country at their own expense.

## **7. VISA AND TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS**

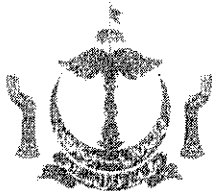
- 7.1 The successful applicant is required to be in a possession of a passport valid for the whole duration of their study in Brunei Darussalam.
- 7.2 The air ticket will be arranged by the Brunei Darussalam Foreign Mission in the scholar's country of origin or the closest Brunei Darussalam Mission to that country. If the scholar purchases his/her ticket without prior authorization from the relevant Brunei authorities, the scholar forfeits his/her right to the ticket and/or reimbursement for the ticket.
- 7.3 The scholar's Student Visa will only be issued upon arrival in Brunei Darussalam. Entry visa for scholars from countries that have a Brunei Darussalam Foreign Mission will be arranged by the respective Missions. For others, a visa upon arrival will be arranged by the Brunei Ministry of Education.

- 9.2 The Government of Brunei Darussalam reserves the right to reject any applicants. Award will not be made if there are no applicants with sufficient merit. The decision on the selection of candidates is final. Any disputes or enquiries pertaining to the decision made will not be entertained.

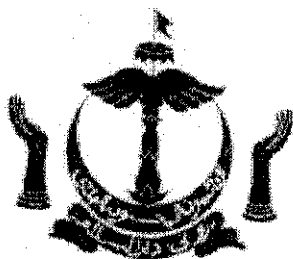

Applicants must also note that fulfilling the general entry requirements and specific entry requirements does not guarantee entry into UBD's programmes as admission to all programmes is competitive and limited subject to availability of space.

#### 1.1 Entry Requirement for Ph.D. Programmes

##### i) General entry requirements.

The minimum requirement for a Ph.D. Programme is normally a relevant Master's Degree or its equivalent from institutions recognized by the University Senate. Applicants are also required to submit a detailed research proposal, which is normally expected to include the following: proposed title; rationale; aims and methodology; literature review; preliminary bibliography; provisional timetable; provisional table of contents, and an indication of any special requirements for the study. The maximum duration of a Ph.D. programme is normally 5 years full-time or 7 years part-time.

##### ii) Specific entry requirements for Ph.D. programmes can be obtained in **Attachment A.**

#### 1.2 Entry Requirement for Master Degree Programmes

##### i) General entry requirements.

- The minimum requirement for a Master's Degree Programme is normally a relevant Bachelor's Degree with Honours (Second Class Honours and above) or its equivalent from institutions recognized by the University Senate, unless otherwise stated.
- Applicants who do not possess a Second Class Honours Degree may be considered, provided they have relevant working experience and possess other academic or professional qualifications deemed suitable and equivalent for the purpose of admission to the programme.
- For entry to the Master's degree programme in English medium, applicants must be able to demonstrate English language proficiency with at least a credit 6 in English Language at GCE 'O' Level Examination or a grade 'C' in IGCSE English (as a Second Language) or an IELTS score of 6.0 or TOEFL minimum overall score of at least 550. Please take note that other specific entry requirements may be provided under the separate programmes.
- For a Master's degree by Research, the applicant must submit a research proposal with the application. The research proposal is generally expected to include the following: proposed title; rationale; aims and methodology; literature review; preliminary bibliography; provisional timetable; provisional table of contents, and an indication of any special requirements for the study.

ii) Master's by Research

Currently, Master's by Research offered by various programmes are available. The duration of the Master's by Coursework is 1 year full-time (or 2 years part-time) and Master's by Research is 2 years full-time (or 4 years part-time).

- The **Bachelor of Engineering (Honours)** programme requires the following minimum qualifications:
  - A minimum of 260 points for three (3) 'A' Level passes (The GCE 'A' Level passes must include Mathematics and either Physics or Chemistry and passing a qualifying interview)
  - An International Baccalaureate with a score of at least 28 points with a minimum of 5 points in relevant subjects which must include Mathematics and either Physics or Chemistry at higher level and pass a qualifying interview.
  - Applicants with other qualifications such as Higher National Diploma (HND) may be admitted on a case by case basis subject to being able to fulfill equivalent requirements and approval from the Dean of Faculty of Integrated Technologies.

The application must come with a well-developed research proposal that demonstrates the applicant's solid familiarity with relevant sociological/anthropological literature, methodology of research and a doable research issue. Appropriate relevant experience and publication, which demonstrates applicant's analytical ability, is a definite weightage.

### **Master of Arts in Sociology**

Applicants must meet the minimum qualification set by the University for Admission to graduate studies, including a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution, with at least an upper second class standing. TOEFL is usually required for students (please check the university website for general requirements). A background in Sociology or Anthropology is required. Admission to the program is at the discretion of the programme's Graduate Committee and is purely based on academic record, letters of recommendation, and substantial research proposal. A research proposal with specific objectives, methodologies and relevant literature is a must for the admission evaluation which should demonstrate applicant's preparation for postgraduate studies.

### **Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Professional Communication and The Media**

Applicants must possess a Master's degree, or a first-class Honours degree, from Universiti Brunei Darussalam or any other university recognised by Universiti Brunei Darussalam.

### **Master of Arts in Professional Communication and The Media**
